2012 Dyngus Day Parade Award Categories - Awards are based on creativity, originality and spirit:

Dyngus Day Capital of the World Award: To be awarded to a float or participating group that best visually depicts Buffalo's unique distinction as "Dyngus Day Capital of the World."

Best Use of Red & White: To be awarded to the float or participating group that most effectively uses the colors of Polonia to decorate a float, vehicle or costume.

Best Use of Pussy Willows: Will challenge participants to make a float or a costume out of pussy willows or to use the most pussy willows in their parade entry.

Best Musical Performance: Awarded to the most animated, colorful and unique musical parade performance. From polka bands to kazoo choirs, all are eligible.

Best Family Float or Group: A great way to get Grandma in the Parade! The Dyngus Day Parade encourages families to march as a group or to participate with a family float. This award will go to the family that best demonstrates their collective Polish Pride.
